**Overview**

The question tested students' ability to understand a Latin text by asking them to answer certain content and stylistic questions about *Pro Caelio* 25.61.

**Sample: 6A**

**Score: 7**

All responses except 2a received credit; 2a lost credit because *pudenti* was not accurately translated.

**Sample: 6B**

**Score: 5**

The following responses did not receive credit:

- 1: does not accurately translate the Latin;
- 2a: inaccurately translates *pudenti*;
- 3: gives incorrect figure of speech.

**Sample: 6C**

**Score: 4**

The following responses did not receive credit:

- 2a: qualities cited do not appear in the passage;
- 2b: connection mentioned does not appear in the passage;
- 3: figure of speech cited does not appear in the passage;
- 5: (1 point) does not mention the location.
