ERRATUM NOTICE

There is an error on the blue Section II: Concentration envelope in the 2007 AP Studio Art portfolio that is distributed to AP Studio Art students for assembly on or before May 11th.

The error concerns Questions 1 and 2 on the back of the envelope, below the subtitle Written Commentary. These questions are not consistent with the questions that appear in the 2007 *AP Studio Art Course Description* or on the back of the 2006-07 AP Studio Art poster.

Please advise students who are submitting a Studio Art portfolio to disregard the questions on the envelope, and to respond according to the ideas that they have developed during the school year. The correct questions are:

1. What is the central idea of your concentration?
2. How does the work in your concentration demonstrate the exploration of your idea? You may refer to specific slides as examples.

Students should record their responses to these questions in the spaces provided on the blue envelope.

NOTE: The written commentary responses are NOT graded; they provide information that is intended to help the Readers better understand the student's body of work. There is no incorrect answer for this written commentary, nor is there a penalty if a student inadvertently answers the questions printed on the envelope.
