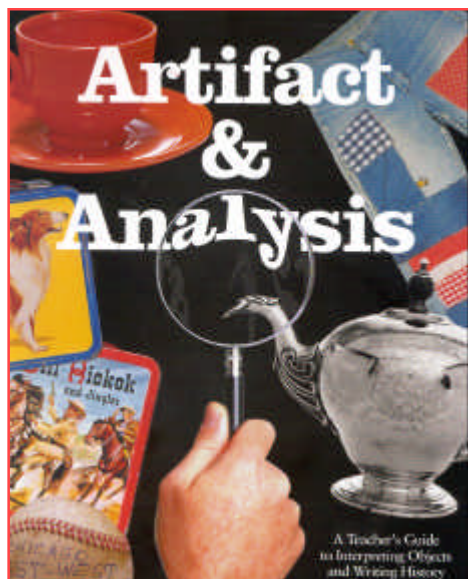


# *Artifact and Analysis: A Teacher's Guide to Interpreting Objects and Writing History*
